



1. WATER FEATURE CONCEPT

The Water Feature design concept must portray an aesthetically harmonious and naturally balanced decoration that will complement a balcony or garden, overlooking a skyline of scenery. The choices of scenery for the backdrop will be given after the submitting the competition registration.

It is COMPULSORY to incorporate a **water feature** into the design concept, in addition to utilizing flowers, plants and other materials for the creation of a beautiful balcony or garden. All potted plants & fresh flowers must be maintained throughout the 10 days exhibition.

- A "Title" is to be adopted with a brief description (in less than 30 words) and will be displayed on the description card.
- Decorate the assigned zone with 70% of softscape of fresh cut flowers and plants, 30% of hardscape with the accent of a WATER FEATURE
- Plants, Props & backdrop can be move in the designated booth on 11th June 2014 (Wednesday)
- Displays need to be fully completed between <u>9.00am 6.00pm</u> on 12th June 2014 (Thursday)
- Judging will commence on 13th June 2014 (Friday)
- Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entertained
- Winners will be announced on the official opening on 14th June 2014 (Saturday)
- Participants need to dismantle and clear away ALL their design and displayed materials on 23rd June, 2014 (Monday) between 9am -5pm


Space Details

- i. Open floor area W 3000mm x D 3000mm x H 2400mm
- ii. Inkjet backdrop wall with skyline of selected scenery
- iii. Brown carpeted floor
- iv. 4 nos.100W long arm spotlight
- v. I no. power point
- vi. Descriptions stand

Winners will receive a trophy, certificate and cash prizes of RM1500, RM800 and R500 for the Gold, Silver and Bronze respectively.

2. POTTED GARDEN

The idea is to create a potted floral garden design impact for a specific space of reception for hotels or offices. Participants have a choice of their own containers, pots, dish, bowl or any form of structure within the dimensions specified below, in achieving a distinctive design concept. Condition of plants & flowers and other materials shall be monitored and maintained to maximize its lifespan for the 10 days exhibition.

- A "Title" is to be adopted and it will be displayed on the description card
- NO restriction in height, the base of the design should NOT exceed 600mm width.
- Potted Garden MUST comprise the following: 70% of fresh material potted plants used should feature a
 combination of minimum 2 genera with a composition of 8 or more varieties of orchid plants, with 30% of
 others elements of rocks, drift wood or structure. Miniature accessories are allowed.
- Mechanical aids (e.g. wires etc) are allowed, but should not be visible to the eye
- Design piece must be created by the participant
- Displays need to be fully completed & displayed at the designated competition zone between 9.30am to 11.00am on 12th June. 2014 (Thursday)
- Judging will commence on 13th June 2014 (Friday)
- Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entertained
- Winners will be announced on the official opening on 14th June 2014 (Saturday)
- Participants need to dismantle and clear away ALL their design and displayed materials on 23rd June, 2014 (Monday) between 9am -5pm

Space Details

- i. Open floor area with two different choices in heights of display cubical stands
- ii. W1000mm x D600mm x H1030mm (Tall unit) & H760mm (Low unit) cubical stand
- iii. Description board (on cubical stand)

Winners will receive a trophy, certificate and cash prizes of RM300, RM200 and RM100 for the Gold, Silver and Bronze respectively and 2 discretionary Merit Award will receive a certificate and cash prize of RM50 each.

3. BODY FLOWERS - Fantasy Characters (Legends / Heroes / Fairytales)

Participants are required to create a piece of Body Flowers in the 'Theme of Fantasy Characters' as the competition piece. This Fantasy Characters theme include Legendary characters, Heroes or Superheroes, and Fairytale characters that brings to life, childhood fantasy characters that children basically grow up with, as their heroes, mentors or inspiration in their lives.

Mannequins will be provided for this competition; it can be collected from the organizer for pre-structured and other dried materials installation 3 days before the competition. Proper steps should be taken to ensure materials used are fully conditioned and stay fresh for up to 10 days throughout the entire event.

- A "Title" is to be adopted with a brief description (in less than 30 words) and will be displayed on the description card
- Structures, dried materials, gluing, wiring and taping can be prepared in advanced on the mannequin assigned. NO prior assembly of fresh materials are permitted on the body of mannequin before the contest. Total design composition should utilize 60% of fresh flowers materials, 40% of other dried materials and/or decorative ornaments.
- Displays need to be fully completed between 2.00 pm to 6.00pm on 12th June. 2014 (Thursday)
- Judging will commence on 13th June2014 (Friday)
- Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entertained
- Winners will be announced on the official opening on, 14th June 2014 (Saturday)
- Participants need to dismantle and clear away ALL their design and displayed materials on 23rd June, 2014 (Monday) between 9am -5pm

Space Details

- i. Standard mannequins provided (females & males)- please state your choice in the competition registration form
- ii. Mannequin stands –low round pedestal Diameter 600mm x H400mm
- iii. 1 no.100W long arm spotlight each
- iv. Description card

Winners will receive a trophy, certificate and cash prizes of RM600, RM300 and RM200 for the Gold, Silver and Bronze respectively and 2 discretionary Merit Award will receive a certificate and cash prize of RM100 each.

4. BRIDAL BOUQUET

Competitors have the option to use the floral foam bridal bouquet holder, or to bind the flowers using any other appropriate bouquet technique. Bouquet has to stay fresh for the judging and be maintained throughout the FLORIA event.

- A "Title" is to be adopted with a brief description to be displayed on the description card
- Arrangement should comprise 60% of fresh materials. Overall width should be in proportion to the silhouette H1750mm NO restriction in length. Design piece must be able to detach from holder ring for judging. Artificial flowers are not permitted.
- Displays need to be fully completed from 11.30pm to 1.00pm on 12th June 2014 (Thursday)
- Judging will commence on 13th June2014 (Friday)
- Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entertained
- Winners will be announced on the official opening on 14th June 2014 (Saturday)
- Participants need to dismantle and clear away ALL their design and displayed materials on 23rd June, 2014 (Monday) between 9am -5pm

Space Details

- I. Open floor area with individual DIE-CUT dark grey lady silhouette H1750mm, with adjustable hands secured on the black wall to hold the bouquet
- II. 1 no.100W long arm spotlight each
- III. Description card

Winners will receive a trophy, certificate and cash prizes of RM300, RM200 and RM100 for the Gold, Silver and Bronze respectively and 2 discretionary Merit Award will receive a certificate and cash prize of RM50 each.
